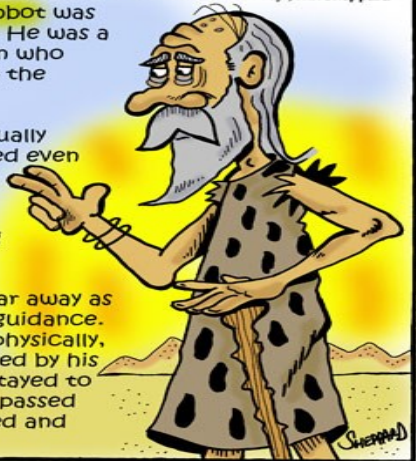

St. Anthony the Abbot was an Egyptian hermit. He was a very spiritual person who believed in LIVING the Jesus life.

When people eventually found him, he moved even further away, eating only bread and water, praying, fasting and wearing skins as clothing.

Wise men from as far away as Greece sought his guidance. Some were healed physically, many were comforted by his words and others stayed to learn from him. He passed away at one hundred and five years old.

For the next couple of months we will honor the former priests of our parish at the Tuesday Low Mass since after the Mass the Marian Movement of priest’s rosary is said for all clergy asking for our Lady’s intercession and blessings. **Father J. P. Moskopp** succeeded Fr. Treumper in May of 1911. He was of German ancestry and served in Laurel until 1914. He built himself a home from his private funds and lived in it for the time he served here. Fr. Moskopp brought many German families into the parish here in Laurel. He must have been a charismatic man because so many new people started to attend church that it became necessary to build churches in Joliet and Bridger. It was the custom in those days that priests were moved often and in the months of November-January. So it happened that Fr. Moskopp was transferred to Baker/Plevna in 1914 before the churches were completed.
